NOTICE – The 2019 Montana Legislature enacted requirements for licensed real estate salespersons and brokers to carry mandatory errors and omissions insurance. The Legislature also required that the Board offer a group policy to its salespersons and brokers. RISC was selected as the official group policy provider. We are looking forward to working with Montana licensees.

Montana real estate license renewal procedures require all brokers and salespersons to apply to renew their license with the Board on or before October 31, 2020. Effective NOVEMBER 1, 2020, all licensed real estate brokers and salespersons are required to maintain continuous E&O insurance. E&O insurance may be purchased through the Board's group policy through RISC – visit www.risceo.com to enroll online and download proof of coverage immediately upon purchase. Licensees may also enroll in the group program by mail. Failure to timely obtain or renew E&O insurance is a violation of Montana real estate licensing law. New licensees must obtain insurance before their license can be activated. Licensees may purchase insurance outside the group program, provided coverage meets state requirements and proof of coverage is provided to the Board as required by state law.

What Is and Is Not Covered – We urge all licensees to review a sample policy, including the Exclusions section. A sample policy and additional information are available on our website, www.risceo.com, or by calling us toll-free at 1-800-637-7319, ext. 1.

This is a Claims-Made-and-Reported Policy – There is no coverage for claims first made before the beginning or after the end of your individual policy period. If you have any knowledge of a claim; potential claim; or any act, error, omission, fact, or situation that may give rise to a claim against you or your company, it must be reported in writing immediately to your insurance carrier before your current policy period expires. Failure to do so may jeopardize any coverage that would have otherwise been available. Any claim under the group policy must be reported to us in writing during the individual policy period in which it is first made against the insured. Prior Acts and Importance of Timely Renewal – Your "retroactive date" determines whether your insurance applies to claims involving services performed before the new policy's effective date. The retroactive date is the date from which you have continuously maintained uninterrupted E&O insurance with no breaks between policy periods. Even a one-day gap will result in loss of coverage for ALL professional services performed before the new policy's effective date, even if you had E&O insurance when the services were provided and again when the claim arises. If you fail to enroll timely, call RISC immediately to see if you qualify to backdate your individual policy period to November 1, 2020 (subject to approval, \$20 cost if requested more than 60 days after group policy inception). This procedure will not remedy noncompliance with mandatory insurance requirements.

Not Renewing Coverage through the Group Program? Consider an Optional Extended Reporting Period (ERP) Endorsement – There is no coverage for claims that arise after the policy expires unless an ERP is in place. However, claims often arise years after the subject transaction occurred. If you enroll but decide not to renew coverage when the policy expires for any reason, including inactivating or retiring your license, you should consider purchasing a 1, 2, 3, or 5 year ERP endorsement, which extends the reporting date of your policy to apply to claims that arise within the ERP. ERP endorsements may only be purchased during or within 90 days of the end of your individual policy period.

Territory – Licensees domiciled in Montana are insured for real estate services performed anywhere they hold a real estate license, provided the services would require a real estate license if performed in Montana. Licensees not domiciled in Montana are insured for Montana transactions only. Out-of-state licensees may be considered domiciled in Montana if their principal real estate license is affiliated with a real estate office in Montana and they reside within 50 miles of the Montana state line. See the Territory section of the policy for more information.

Effective Date – Licensees who enroll before November 1, 2020 will have an effective date of November 1, 2020. Licensees who enroll after November 1, 2020 will have an inception date of the day we receive the licensee's *completed application and premium*. Licensees may request a different inception date (after November 1, 2020) for Continental's consideration: _____

Premium / Deductible – Once premium has been paid and the policy coverage has incepted, you may not cancel the policy. If your payment is returned for non-sufficient funds, you are responsible for payment of any resulting bank fees or penalties. The deductible will be due in accordance with the policy. Applicant agrees to reimburse Continental for any and all costs and expenses it incurs by employing a collection agency to collect any overdue deductible.

Option for Enrolling E&O Coverage for Multiple Licensees – Companies with 10+ licensees can request a Multiple Licensee Renewal Form to electronically submit enrollment information for all the firm's licensees timely and expediently.

Applicant has reviewed and understands the information contained herein. Applicant declares that the above statements are true and that Applicant has not suppressed or misstated any material facts. Applicant understands that it is a crime to knowingly provide false, incomplete, or misleading information to an insurance company for the purpose of defrauding the company. Penalties include imprisonment, fines, and denial of insurance benefits. Applicant agrees that this application shall be the basis of the contract with the Company and that coverage, if written, will be provided on a claims-made-and-reported basis. Applicant understands and agrees that the completion of this application does not bind the Company to issue a policy.

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ENROLLMENT FORM

Effective November 1, 2020, Montana law requires that all real estate brokers and salespersons carry and maintain E&O insurance that applies to all licensed activities. E&O insurance may be purchased through the Board's group policy through RISC. Licensees may purchase insurance outside the group program, provided coverage meets state requirements and proof of coverage is provided to the Board as required by state law.

ENROLL ONLINE – Recommended Due to the October 31, 2020 License Renewal Deadline and November 1, 2020 Insurance Requirement.

Enroll online at www.risceo.com with a Visa or MasterCard and receive a certificate of coverage immediately upon completion (a nonrefundable \$5 convenience fee applies to online enrollment).

ENROLL BY MAIL – We will make every effort to expedite enrollment forms received by mail, but please be mindful that postal services are processing and delivering much higher than normal volume due to COVID-19, which is contributing to delivery delays across the country. For this reason and the late launch of the group program, online enrollment is encouraged.

To enroll by mail, 1. Complete the licensee information section, 2. Select desired coverages, and 3. Send completed form (both pages) with a check or money order payable to RISC.
